Restomod Billet Automatic Shifter Handle

OK, troops! If you read Restomod News, you know that this shifter handle isn't even available yet. But I thought I'd do a install article on it just to show you how easy it goes on. We should have them in stock around the middle of May and they will be available in two styles: all polished billet and polished billet with black anodized grips.

There are two major pieces to this shifter handle. One is the billet handle itself. The other is the stainless steel button for the side. Here's how it goes on.

Step 1.) Loosen the allen screw that holds the stock shifter handle onto the tower and slide it up and off.

Step 2.) The top of the shifter tower has a little lead ball pointing to the drivers side. By pulling the ball to the right, it releases the pawl that holds the shifter in gear and lets you select another gear. Take a good look at it and see how it works.

Step 3.) Take a good look at the new stainless steel shifter button. Notice on one side of the square hole that it has a pocket to the button side. This is where the lead ball sits. When the button is pushed with your thumb, it pulls the lead ball over to the right and releases the pawl so that you can change gears. If this is installed upside down, the button will not work.

Step 4.) Slide the new Restomod Billet Handle over the shifter tower while at the same time holding the stainless steel button in the proper position with the pocket for the lead ball pointed down. Slide the handle on and press the button with your thumb. It should work correctly. If not, start over, making sure that the pocket for the lead ball pointed down.

Step 5.) Tighten up the allen screw that holds the handle to the tower and you're done! Now you can enjoy the new look! But a note of caution. NEVER! And I mean never! Put Lock Tight on the allen screw. If the screw loosens up and you feel you need to secure it, use a dab of silicone sealer or RTV. It will hold the screw in place but not tight enough to cause you to strip it out when you have to remove it later.
